PLANTATION SWIM CLUB RULES 2024

Violation of Plantation Swim Club policies may result in the loss of privileges; and membership fees will NOT be refunded.

ENTRY: Members must have a key fob to enter the pool. The gate must be kept closed. Do not open the gate for other members.

GUESTS: For each guest, the member must complete a liability waiver (once per season) and pay a \$5.00 fee (per guest per visit). The waiver form and payment portal can be found at <u>https://plantationswim.weebly.com/</u> Guests must be accompanied by a member at all times.

DIVING BOARD: The diving board is to be used with caution at all times. Weight limit on the board is 250 pounds. Only one person is permitted on the board at a time. Swimmers must access the diving board by use of the ladder. No hanging off the side or end of the diving board. Divers must be sure the deep end is clear of swimmers before diving. No floatation devices can be used in the deep end while the diving board is in use. Swimmers should clear the board side of the deep end when the board is being used.

SAFETY RULES

- 1. Plantation Swim Club is swim at your own risk. No lifeguards are on duty.
- 2. Children under 15 years of age must be accompanied by a club member 18 years of age or older. Club members 18 years of age or older are permitted to swim alone but swimming "with a buddy" is always encouraged.
- 3. Parents must watch their own children at all times, in and out of the water. An adult must be in the water with a child wearing flotation devices. Parents are expected to ensure that their children follow all the pool rules. If a parent is not properly supervising their children they may be asked to leave.
- 4. **<u>NO GLASS</u>** is allowed on the Plantation Swim Club premises. This is a Gwinnett County ordinance, and strictly enforced.
- 5. No running, horseplay or throwing people into the pool. All children and guest should be made aware of this rule.
- 6. No diving into the shallow areas of the pool from the side.
- 7. No hairpins or metal objects in the pool.
- 8. Flotation devices, toys and games are allowed only if they do not interfere with regular swimming.
- 9. No spitting or spouting water allowed in the pool area.
- 10. No animals allowed inside the fenced pool area unless they are a certified support animal. No animals allowed in the pool.
- 11. No skates, bikes or skateboards allowed in the fenced area.
- 12. No hanging onto the deep end buoyed safety line.

HEALTH and FACILITY RULES

- 13. No underage alcohol consumption is allowed on pool property. All alcohol consumption should be limited, only responsible drinking.
- 14. Smoking (tobacco and vaping) permitted in designated areas only. These areas are the deckside corner table by the back fence and the two tables just in front of the grill area.
- 15. No chewing gum allowed in the pool area.
- 16. No food, drink or pool furniture allowed within 5 feet of the pool.
- 17. The baby pool is for small children, if small children are present; please keep older children out of the baby pool unless they are supervising or playing with the small children.
- 18. All members and guests are expected to be courteous and respectful of the other members and of the pool grounds. This includes the use of profanity or loud music.
- 19. Clean up after yourselves and use receptacles provided for trash and recycling. There is no paid cleaning staff. It is all members' responsibility to keep the entire pool facility clean.

DRESS CODE

- 20. Only appropriate swimwear is allowed in the pool. No cut-offs or material that is frayed is allowed as it may interfere with the pool's filtering equipment.
- 21. Children NOT potty trained are required to wear little swimmers and rubber pants beneath swimsuits.
